- IV. Other Items – Dori reported the sinkhole and subsidence along the trail in Reach E. She is working with DEQ and Butte's Superfund group to get it filled and the trail repaired.

Dori reported on the Great American Rail-Trail launch in Whitehall and the energy that seems to be emerging related to additional trail connections. Milo related to the Board the connections to the west from Anaconda to Drummond – Dori is going to look at that alignment.

- V. Project Updates

- a. Railroad Discussions:

Highway 1 Project: MDT had their regular meeting with ADL personnel. Chas related that MDT was waiting for some updated cost estimates for the P19 underpass alternatives and MDT had completed a legal review of the authority related to any work done within the easement area under p19. Dori requested confirmation of that information from Joe Walsh. When the cost estimates are updated a meeting will be held with ADL CE Bill Everett to discuss alternatives.

Reach G: Collette has completed the technical memo and preliminary drawings. Dori and Collette will contact Matt Mavrinc with Patriot about the proposal.

- b. Land Discussions

- i. Ueland Appraisal - The Board discussed the reservation/cost of the land exchange and bridge costs. Dori will work with Brian and Pat to finalize the purchase stipulations before meeting with the Uelands.
- ii. Peterson Exchange – The BSB Council of Commissioners approved accepting the DEQ-owned portion of the Old Milwaukee Road to secure motorized access to the German Gulch trailhead and secure the ramp access for the primary Silver Bow Creek Greenway trail. A resolution will be prepared by the BSB County Attorney for adoption.
- iii. Butana – Alternative Route - The R/W Division of MDT is researching the ownership of the Stuart Townsite land being considered for an alternative around the Butana property.
