The Draft Final Butte Priority Soils Operable Unit Health Study presents the results of the first phase in a series of public health studies that looks at the effectiveness of the Residential Metals Abatement Program (RMAP) for the Butte Priority Soils Operable Unit (BPSOU) Superfund site in Silver Bow County, Montana.

A public meeting will be held April 9<sup>th</sup> from 3:30 to 7:30 p.m. at the Copper Auditorium at the Mining City Center located at 400 West Park Street in Butte. During the public meeting, study investigators and collaborators will provide more information about the study and will be available to answer questions from community members. Community members are encouraged to provide written comments on the draft final study report during the April 9<sup>th</sup> meeting or by emailing [dpowers@bsb.mt.gov](mailto:dpowers@bsb.mt.gov). A final study report, which will reflect comments received and include a response to comment summary prepared by the study Working Group representatives, will be submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency in July 2014. Comments related to the draft final report must be received no later than April 29, 2014 for evaluation and inclusion as appropriate in the final report.
