- a. The Board of Health is asked to authorize a contract between the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services and the Butte-Silver Bow Health Department to provide HIV Medical Case Management and Emergency Financial Assistance. This is an annual contract in the amount of \$20,354.00 for the time period of July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023.
- b. The Board of Health is asked to authorize a contract between the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services and the Butte-Silver Bow Health Department to reduce the burden of vaccine preventable disease within Silver Bow County by ensuring the oversight and provision of immunization services for children, adolescents, and adults. This is an annual contract in the amount of \$15,549.00 for the time period of July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023.
- c. The Board of Health is asked to authorize an amendment to the Healthy Montana Families Program contract between the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services and the Butte-Silver Bow Health Department to provide home visiting and family support services under the Nurse-Family Partnership evidence-based home visiting model in Butte-Silver Bow. The

amendment adds \$16,223.00 to the contract amount of \$111,709.00 for a total of \$127,932.00. Term of the contract is Oct. 1, 2021 through Sept. 30, 2022.

- d. The Board of Health is asked to authorize an amendment to the Maternal & Child Health Block Grant Program contract between the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services and the Butte-Silver Bow Health Department to designate the Butte-Silver Bow Health Department as a Family Planning Clinic. Term of the contract is June 30, 2022 through Sept. 30, 2022.
